



Quick Tips Reading Aloud with Children



Allow children to identify different animals or objects on the book cover. Who are the characters? What is it about?



Ask children open ended questions about the book. Ex: What do you think will happen?



Be a dramatic reader! Try different voices for each character and be yourself.



Slow Down! Allow yourself to process what is happening on the page. Enjoy the story and the beautiful illustrations.



Be consistent. Make reading aloud a part of your daily routine!
